The region boasts four distinct seasons with a diversity of temperatures and predictable day-to-day weather. Summers and springs are warm, autumns are cool, dry and colorful, and winters entail just the right amount of snow. The result is residents and visitors are happy with both the variety and the lack of extremes experienced in more northern or southern locations.
