

Union Presence & Activity

- Virginia is a right-to-work state; accordingly, labor unions and employers are prohibited from establishing contract agreements that solely employ unionized workers.
- In 2016, union membership in the Gateway Region and the Commonwealth stood at 6.1 percent and 4.3 percent, respectively.
- There has not been any worked stoppage in any of the Gateway Region communities since 1993 (source: Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service, 2017 Q3).
