



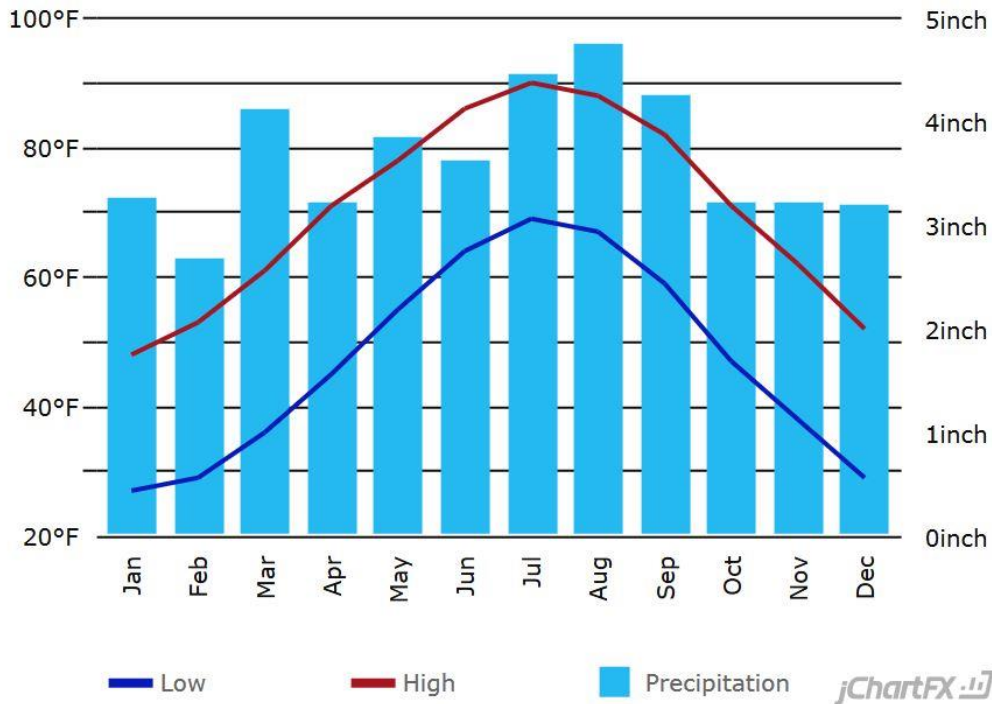
Weather & Climate

Summers and springs are warm, autumns are cool, dry and colorful, and winters entail just the right amount of snow.
